Permaculture Weekend

Community Assembly training at Mint Lane Hub

Community Assemblies are a structured way for a group of people to discuss issues or make decisions collectively, so that all voices are heard and valued equally, and no one person or group dominates the

discussion. They are a great way to generate ideas, gather feedback and make decisions.

On the 7th October fourteen local people attended a Community Assembly training session at the Mint Lane Hub. There, the process, organisation and key elements of a Community Assembly were introduced. The training generated lively discussion and great enthusiasm to hold Community Assemblies in Lincoln.

Following our Community Assembly training we had our first Community Assembly at Mint Lane on Saturday 28th November, entitled ‘Greening Lincoln’. After an introduction by Rosemary Robinson, the facilitator, we split into three groups, discussing a broad range of ideas, including better public transport; how we can reduce our reliance on cars to get around; greening our open spaces and growing more sustainable food. 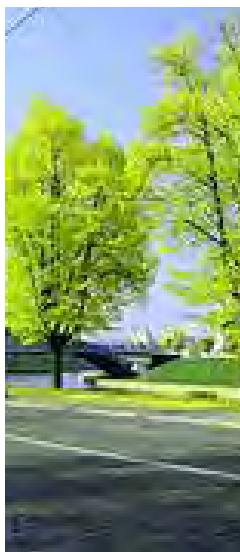
