Lincolnshire Energy Conference on 25th February – Extinction Rebellion's Protest at the event

Extinction Rebellion held a peaceful protest outside the Isaac Newton building at the University of Lincoln on Tuesday 25th February, where the Lincolnshire Energy Conference was held. Members of EarthLincs and Extinction Rebellion were originally refused places at the Conference but following a change of heart by the organisers, were allowed to attend.

The conference was organised by Lincolnshire County Council with the stated aim of exploring 'innovative solutions, investment opportunities, and strategies to create an affordable, resilient energy future for Lincolnshire and beyond.' However, the list of speakers included climate sceptics and those who have a vested interest in exploiting the County's gas and oil reserves.

XR spokesperson, Rosemary Robinson, said:

'Our view that the conference would be biased in favour of continued fossil fuel exploration and exploitation in the County was confirmed by the list of speakers. Dr John Constable and County Councillor Colin Davie are both directors of the Renewable Energy Foundation, a charity which has close ties to the climate science denial campaign group the Global Warming Policy Foundation.'

'George Yates is the president and CEO of Heyco Energy Group, a fossil fuel exploration and investment company based in Texas. He made an announcement about the vast gas reserves recently discovered in the Gainsborough Trough, lobbying to extract the gas by fracking. The Labour Government has banned fracking and will issue no new oil and gas licences, but we cannot be complacent in the face of the huge and influential fossil fuel companies who will go to any lengths to maximise profits, knowingly risking the lives of billions as CO2 emissions continue to heat the planet to dangerous levels.'
